So using something recognizable like the Google colours creates a sense of urgency for that crucial offline community kids need. This idea can also lend itself naturally to a campaign by using the look and feel of other online platforms that kids turn to such as: Tiktok, Instagram and Snapchat.

Insight:

The first place most kids turn to when they need help is a search engine. But that search engine can't offer personal advice. That search engine doesn't know what a child is really going through. Which is why we want the adults in their lives to step up and be that first point of contact for any kids that need help.
